



# Clitherall Lake Recommended Wake Boat Area

**Areas that are 500 feet from Shore and greater than 20 feet deep**

Use of this area decreases shoreline impacts and resuspension of sediment  
Be sure to fully treat or drain ballast and bilge water to prevent the spread of AIS

**You are responsible for your wake – Be aware of other boaters and hazards**

Not suitable for navigation - Lake depths and distances determined from

### Own Your Wake

Large wakes produced by some watercraft operated at certain speeds can cause a number of negative impacts, including:

- Shoreline erosion, which results in impaired water quality and property loss
- Damage to others property, including docked boats.
- Hazards to public safety both on the water and on shore
